Learning Language at Super Fast Speed Workshop

DATES: October 26-27, 2017 (immediately following ILI Symposium 2017)

PLACE: Buffalo Thunder Hotel, 20 Buffalo Thunder Trail, (Pueblo of Pojoaque) Santa Fe, New Mexico 87506

INSTRUCTOR: Finlay Macleod was born on Lewis in the Western Isles, Scotland and grew up with Scottish Gaelic everyday language, but he himself did not speak it fluently until age 18 after eight years of self-motivated learning from fluent speakers in his extended family. In the late 70s he became the Chief Executive of Comhairle nan Sgoiltean Araich (CNSA), the Gaelic Pre-school Council to promote Gaelic throughout the country. The CNSA slowly moved towards a philosophy that believes parents, other adults and family, and then children (in that order) are the future of Gaelic. His 30+ years of experience in teaching and promoting Gaelic showed that helping adults become fluent speakers is the priority, so that they can surround the child(ren) with the language in the homes. Mr. Macleod is the founder of the Moray Language Centre that offers Gaelic courses using the Total Immersion Plus (TIP) approach to learning to speak the language in a short time, designed mainly for adults.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This training workshop addresses the critical need of all our communities, which is, "producing speakers of the language." We must create fluency in adults so they can then have language in the homes for the children. Over the two-days of this workshop, participants will learn methodologies and strategies to become conversant in a language in 200 hours or less. The method involves the Total Immersion Plus (TIP) and dedicated time to implement a full immersion environment. The course is very hands-on. It is highly recommended for everyone of all ages involved in language revitalization in communities – speakers, parents, parents-to-be, learners, grandparents, guardians, teachers, language program administrators, tribal leaders.

If flying into the Santa Fe Municipal Airport (SAF), 121 Aviation Drive, Santa Fe, NM 87507. This is approximately 25 minutes away from the hotel. Avis and Hertz Car Rentals are located at this airport. RoadRunner Shuttle is located at this airport.

The hotel is located 15-20 minute drive North of Santa Fe and over 80 miles North of the Albuquerque Sunport Airport (ABQ). The hotel does not have shuttle service for the ABQ airport, they only offer shuttle services between their Buffalo Thunder Resort & Casino, Cities of Gold Casino and to the Santa Fe Depot (train station).
